Access Pass holders may store their boats at the lake during the summer months. Only non-motorized crafts are allowed. Access Pass holders must register and supply their own boat.

Camping

We have two primitive campsites set back from the lake. These sites are usually available. Reservations are required.

Fishing

The lake is open to all access pass holders for fishing throughout the year. The most plentiful fish are bass. All DEC regulations apply.

Lifeguards are on duty (weather/water quality permitting) from 11 am to 7 pm June 13-Aug 12.
