

WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP ACADEMY APPLICATION INFORMATION

We seek individuals (women and men) who are intellectually curious and ready to participate in a rigorous academic and experience-based study of leadership. A particular GPA is not a prerequisite for admission, but please note that academic *and* judicial records will be reviewed.

Page One: Summary/Resume

1. Name, contact information (phone, campus address, email)
2. Academic major/minor
3. Year of expected graduation and current (at the time of application) class standing
4. Brief statement or summary of your campus activities (including employment) to date. If you have not joined any activities or clubs, please explain your high school experience in this aspect. *This should be no more than 75 words.*
5. Names and contact information (email and phone numbers with area code) of three references (AU faculty/staff preferred). Do not list relatives or friends. *Please ask your references for their permission before you list them!*

Page Two: Transcripts

Please attach the most current academic record available. Downloads from BannerWeb are acceptable.

Page Three: Essay

Write a *one-page*, double spaced essay on one of the following prompts. *Be sure you write the essay with care. Grammar, spelling and mechanics matter.*

1. My leadership strengths and weaknesses and how the Academy will help me.
2. Why you believe that focusing on leadership for women is particularly important.

Page Four: Release

Please type the following statement on a blank sheet of paper, sign and date it.

"I fully understand that my academic and judicial records at Alfred University may be reviewed in consideration of my application to the Women's Leadership Academy. I understand that I may be required to undergo an interview as part of my application. I further understand that my application may be denied or deferred based on information acquired by review of academic records, judicial records, and/or reference checks."
